WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Match the Situation to the Safe Action! Draw a line from each “IF” situation (left column) to the correct “THEN” action (right column).

Then park safely away from buildings, trees, and bridges, then stay inside covering your head.

Then Drop, Cover, and Hold under your desk, then wait for your teacher's instructions.

Then shelter under a sturdy table, or crouch by an inner wall while covering your head.

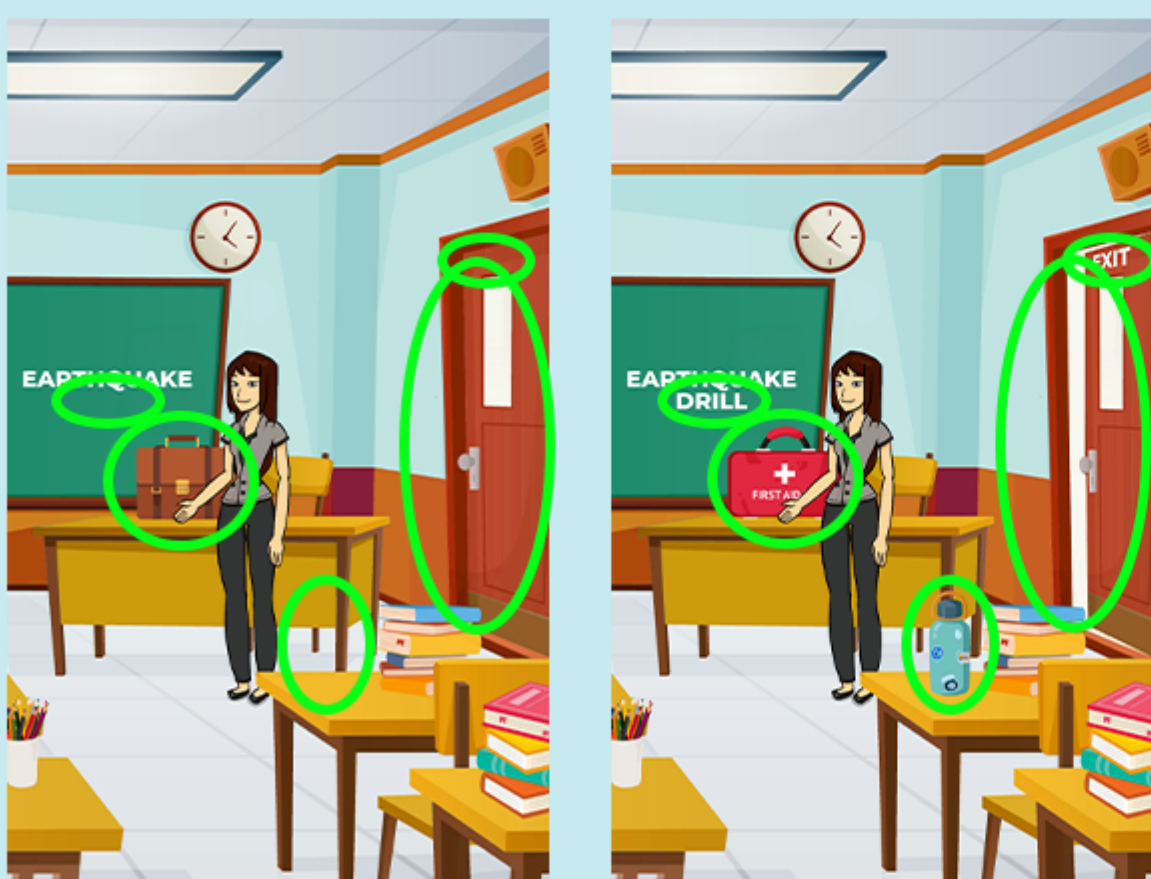

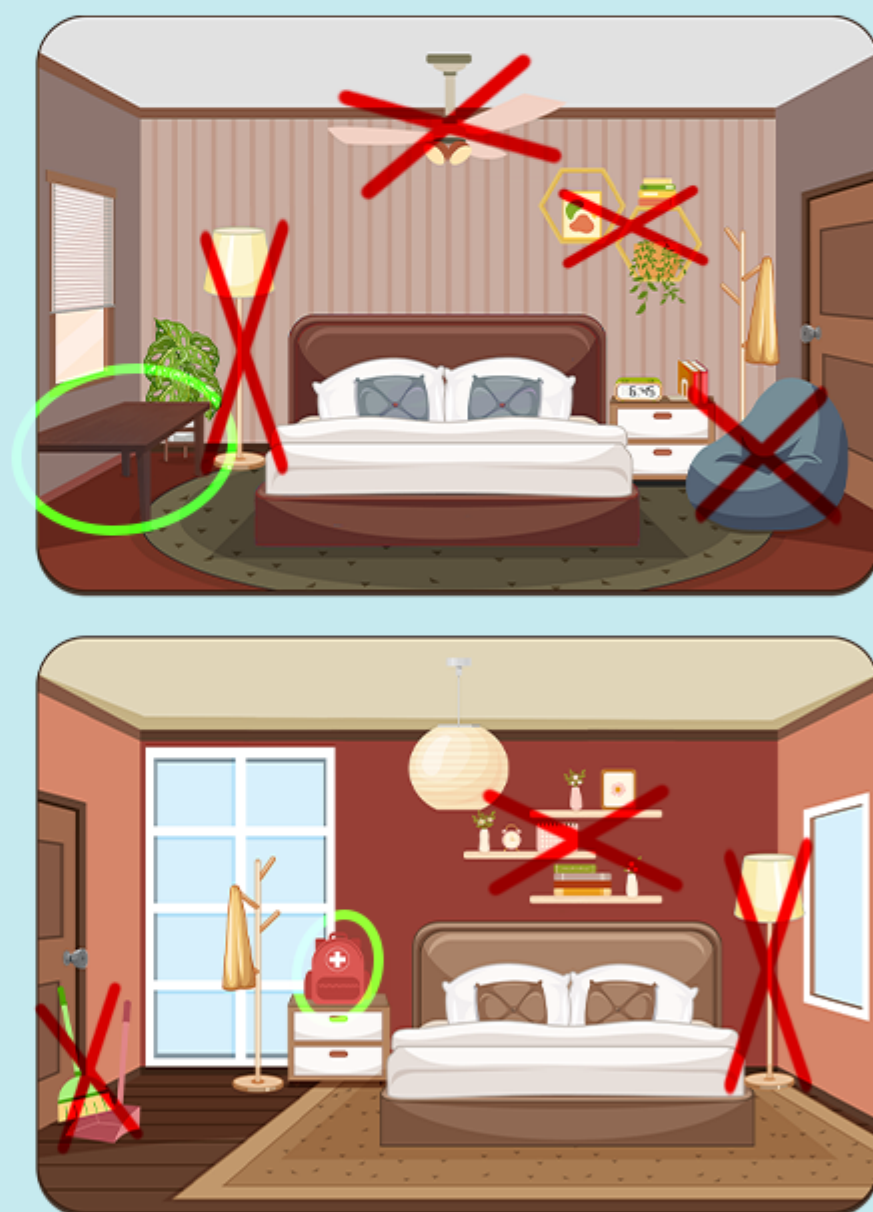
